Characteristics of Introduction

First sentence – catch the reader's attention

<u>Middle sentences</u> – provide general information that keeps the reader engaged

<u>Final sentences</u> – state what you are going to write about *(thesis statement)*

Note: Do not mention yourself, "I," or the reader, "you" in your paper.

Body Paragraph

One look at the Wyvern was enough to insight fear in the bravest knight. Its body was covered, head to tail, in impenetrable scales. Its head had a crown of rock hard bones to protect it from enemies. The dragon's eyes glowed like fire and its strong jaw was filled with razor sharp The Wyvern had two legs as large as teeth. tree-trunks and its feet contained five muscular toes each ending in a talon that could cut flesh with ease. The creature's leathery wings could flap hard enough to produce hurricane strength winds with each point containing another talon. Characteristic of a Body Paragraph

First Sentence – maintain interest and state what the paragraph will be about

Body Sentences – provide the information. Use sentences that *flow* well together and have good *fluency*.

Last Sentence – sum-up what you just wrote about and maintain interest

Characteristics of a Conclusion

- sum-up main ideas
